- 1. How can these false teachers be so bold in their practice (2 Peter 2:10b)? Who are the glorious ones that they blaspheme (cf. Jude 1:8)? How does Peter's comment about angels highlight the severity of what the false teachers are doing (2 Peter 2:11; Jude 1:9)?
- 2. How else does Peter describe false teachers (2 Peter 2:12; Jude 1:10)? How can they be so blind to their own self-destruction (2 Peter 2:13; Isaiah 3:11; Romans 6:23; Galatians 6:7; cf. 2 Corinthians 4:3-4)? How can these verses help us to identify false teachers (Romans 16:17-18)?
- 3. Peter's description of the false teachers is shocking (2 Peter 2:14-15; cf. Jeremiah 6:13). Before we begin to see ourselves as superior to these false teachers, however, how are our lives described before we trusted Jesus Christ as our Savior (Ephesians 2:1-4; Colossians 1:21)?
- 4. Who was Balaam, son of Beor and how are false teachers like him (2 Peter 2:15; Numbers 22:5- 6; 25:3; 31:16; Revelation 2:14)? How did God humble Balaam and expose his sin (2 Peter 2:16; Numbers 22:28-30)? Do you think false teachers would be open to similar humbling?
