2. Why is false teaching so dangerous (2 Peter 2:2; Jude 1:8)? Have you, or someone you know, ever been led astray by a false teacher (2 Peter 2:3; Colossians 2:8; Matthew 24:1)? How can we protect ourselves from becoming false teachers (2 Timothy 2:15-16; Proverbs 12:15)?
3. Who are these angels who sinned (2 Peter 2:4; cf. 1 Peter 3:18-20; Jude 1:6)? What was their sin and why was it so offensive (Genesis 6:1-4)? Are these angels currently in "Hell" or some other place? What does this verse remind us about the supernatural "world" (Ephesians 6:12-13)?
4. How extensive was God's judgment upon the Earth in the days of Noah (2 Peter 2:5; 3:6; Genesis 6:5-7)? Why did God preserve Noah and his family (1 Peter 3:20; Hebrews 11:7)? How does the story of Noah challenge you to live today (Ephesians 4:1-2)?
