Can you think of a time from your childhood when you acted in a way you knew was wrong? What caused you to do it? (peer pressure in school, request from a friend, cultural influence, etc.)

That said, it can be easy for us to slip back into behaviors that do not represent Christ, which is why we must be intentional about the way we live. That is the message at the heart of the book of Titus.
